The government has filed an appeal from two orders by
Magistrate Judge Facciola in this matter regarding the
government's application for an order pursuant to 18 U.S.C.
§ 2705(b). One order, dated March 24, 2014, invited Yahoo, Inc.
("Yahoo") to intervene as a respondent and file a notice with
the court on whether Yahoo intended to be heard on the merits of
the government's application, and further ordered Yahoo not to
disclose to any individual information regarding the
government's ongoing federal grand jury investigation. The
other order, dated March 24, 2014, instructed the government to
file a public redacted copy of its application for a nondisclosure order and a proposed order. The government has also
moved to seal its appeal from the March 24 orders entered. In
