Lead 2 to locate and interview [redacted] and [redacted] at [redacted] Denver, Colorado was completed on 07/22/2004. Four other residents were also contacted at that address and voluntarily identified themselves as [redacted]

[redacted] and [redacted] was not located and no information regarding her current whereabouts was provided by the other residents.

have outstanding local warrants and were arrested by the Denver Police Department at the conclusion of the interviews.

Lead 3 to locate and interview persons at other addresses in Denver was partially successful in that six individuals were contacted at 1025 Lipan Street, but they refused to identify themselves or consent to an interview. Investigation confirmed that this is the current location of Food Not Bombs and Defailer Bicycle Collective. A subsequent newspaper article confirmed that one of the residents at such address is [REDACTED] b7C

No contacts were made at 1435 Lipan Street as such residence was vacant and under renovation. No contacts were attempted at Breakdown Book Collective and Community Space, 1409 Ogden Street, as the purpose of the interviews was served by the contacts made at the two residences. b7C

Leads 4 and 5 to attempt to locate and interview [REDACTED] in Fort Collins and Scott Silber in Boulder were completed by agents in those RAs. Neither [REDACTED] or Silber consented to an interview.
